In this 2-for-1 presentation Bahram Rahman will read and explore two of his stories at the Museum of Lennox and Addington.

The session will feature a reading of *If You See a Bluebird*, which tells the story of Ali, a young Afghan refugee adjusting to life in Canada. Through storytelling and interactive discussions, Rahman explores themes of home, memory, and the emotional challenges faced by refugee children. This session offers a compassionate perspective on resettlement, highlighting resilience and the importance of belonging, all in a child-friendly manner.

Stick around for a reading of *A Sky-Blue Bench*, which tells the story of Aria, an Afghan girl who is going back to school after recovering from an injury. She has a helper-leg, and despite the difficulties she faces, Aria is dete rmined to find a solution to her problems using the limited resources she has access to. The discussion will foc us on Rahman's approach to writing children's books and the personal stories that inspired A Sky-Blue Bench.

MUSICANS @ THE MUSEUM:

Friday, November 29th, 7:00pm: Midwinter in the Prairies - 19th Century songs and stories of the seaso n (Ian Bell and Teilhard Frost)

In Upper Canada "the bleak midwinter" was often in fact, the party season. There was less to do on the farm, an d frozen roads made it easier to get around to visit friends and neighbours. When they did, there was sure to be singing, and if there was fiddle handy - some dancing as well. Teilhard Frost and Ian Bell are a two-person folk festival, bringing this old music alive with singing, storytelling, and a baffling array of instruments including fi ddle, concertina, banjo, harmonica, jaw harp, guitar, bones and button accordion.

<u>Ian Bell</u> has performed across Canada and in the United States since the late 1970s on his own and with a numb er of groups, he has appeared at numerous folk festivals across Canada and abroad, and for many years was a re gular musical contributor on Stuart McLean's Vinyl Café, as well as on Fresh Air and other CBC radio progra ms. Accompanying himself on guitar, concertina, banjo and button accordion, Ian performs both Canadian traditional music and his own songs and instrumental compositions. He's also well known as a great storyteller. Fol lowing the release of three CDs of original material, Ian has returned with two recordings of traditional songs a nd tunes - My Pious Friends & Drunken Companions and his latest, Forget Me Not When Far Away - a collection of songs of the Great Lakes.

<u>Teilhard Frost</u> is a multi-instrumentalist, specializing in traditional fiddle tunes, with a particular interest in the Appalachian Mountains. He has spent the last eighteen years touring with critically acclaimed band Sheesham, L otus and 'Son. This trio is currently working with Hezekiah Proctor and the Hash House Serenaders. In 2018, T eilhard joined forces with musician and engineer Jason Mercer. Together they have created award winning soun dtracks for film and advertising. Teilhard's latest album is 'Four and Twenty Blackbirds Dancing on a Deer Skin ', an album of traditional fiddle and banjo tunes, harmonica bits and ballads.
